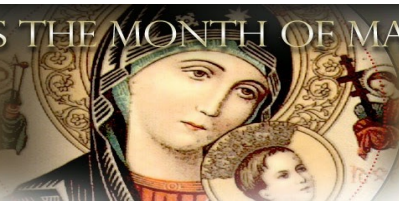

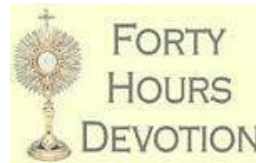
**Donations Needed for Foster Care Program**
